

## VSBC regional and rural mediation panel: application form

The Victorian Small Business Commission (VSBC) is an independent government agency that advocates on issues affecting small business, educates people in small business about their rights and responsibilities, and helps them to avoid or resolve disputes. Everything we do is to empower small businesses with the right tools to avoid or resolve disputes quickly so they can focus on building their businesses.

We have statutory dispute resolution functions under the *Small Business Commission Act* 2017, *Retail Leases Act* 2003, *Owner Drivers and Forestry Contractors Act* 2005 (including a new arbitration function from 2020), *Farm Debt Mediation Act* 2011 and *Commercial Passenger Vehicle Industry Act* 2017. We also have a role to provide alternative dispute resolution in relation to mineral exploration land access disputes under the *Model Commercial Consent Agreement for Access to Private Land in Victoria*.

Our mediation panel is made up of a diverse group of experienced, commercial dispute mediation professionals who work with us to give Victorian small businesses a low cost and highly effective alternative dispute resolution service. Mediations are offered subject to availability. If you would like to be considered for appointment to the panel, you will need to complete and submit this application form with your current resume.

## Selection process

The selection process is competitive. We consider each applicant's declared skills and experience against the needs of our dispute resolution functions. All applications received electronically will be acknowledged by email and treated in confidence. We will notify all applicants of the result of their application by email. As we receive applications from vastly more applicants than we need to appoint, we are unable to enter into discussion with applicants who are unsuccessful in their application.
